Dear Patrons,

At yesterday's board meeting, the board discussed flow rates for the remainder of the season, the board decided to continue at a delivery rate of 5.5 gallons per minute for the remainder of the season. This decision was based on the fact that lowering delivery rates to 4.5 gpm could cause some deliveries to not get water and would only add a couple days. As we use our storage, the district is running as tightly as we can with management of the water and if any patrons are not using their water and wish to help the farmers who are trying to get one good cutting of hay, please call the office to be reduced or shut off.

As we get closer, the District will announce a definitive shut-off date.

Please note, water may be turned back on September 15th, the start of the Shoulder Season, if natural flows are available. We will notify patrons at that time.
