ATTENTION PATRONS:

In light of the latest OWRD storage report, data indicates there is enough natural flow for Arnold Irrigation to turn on at a reduced rate of delivery. The District is set to restart the system beginning tomorrow, Saturday, July 18th, at 4am. The restart will take several days before water reaches the ends.

If your water was **ON** when we shut down on July 2nd, you will receive water when the system is turned back on and fully charged.

If your delivery is on the **MAIN Canal piped section** between China Hat Rd. and Horse Butte Rd., you will need to call the office if you want to be turned **ON**.

If you **DO NOT** want water, please call the office to be turned **OFF**.

The Arnold Irrigation District office will be available for calls and messages this weekend by calling 541.382.7664.

The outlook for how long this natural flow will last is unknown at this time. The District will continue to monitor natural flows in the Deschutes river, and we will keep patrons informed of any potential shut offs.
