Dear Patrons,

The June 1<sup>st</sup> through 14<sup>th</sup> storage report was released Monday night and it shows that the natural flow in the Deschutes river is still reflecting a major drought. As of the 15<sup>th</sup>, Arnold Irrigation District ended the report period with 2053-acre feet of storage and will run out of water between July 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. The district will continue to monitor our storage and will determine the exact shut-off date and time between July 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. As the senior districts have to turn down for the shoulder season, natural flow should become available to AID and we may turn back on to take advantage of the natural flow becoming available September 15<sup>th</sup>.
